The Fremont County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Wednesday, January 12, 2022, in the Fremont County Courthouse Boardroom, with Hickey, Clark, and Sheldon present. A quorum was declared, and the meeting officially called to order at 9:00 a.m. Minutes of the previous board session were read and approved. The agenda was approved as posted.

Let the records show that Treasurer Alise Snyder, Deputy Recorder Pam Daniels, Liz Skillern with Valley News Today, and Ethan Hewett with KMA were present for this meeting.

Treasurer Alise Snyder met with the board for the approval of the semi-annual report. Motion by Sheldon to approve the semi-annual report. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Clark to Rescind Resolution No. 2021-58 regarding the Wellness Program. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Sheldon to set a public hearing date of February 2, 2022 at 9:30 a.m. for consideration of a UTV Ordinance for Fremont County. Motion carried unanimously.

The board discussed Fremont County becoming a 2nd Amendment Sanctuary County. Motion by Clark to approve Resolution No. 2022-5 Declaring Fremont County a Second Amendment Sanctuary County. Motion carried unanimously. RESOLUTION 2022-5

A RESOLUTION DECLARING FREMONT COUNTY TO BE A SECOND AMENDMENT SANCTUARY COUNTY WHEREAS, the right of the people to keep and bear arms is guaranteed as an individual right under the Second Amendment to the United States Constitution, and

WHEREAS, the right of the people to keep and bear arms for defense of life, liberty and property is regarded as an inalienable right of the people of Fremont County, Iowa, and

WHEREAS, the people of Fremont County, Iowa derive economic benefit from all safe forms of firearms recreation, hunting and shooting conducted within Fremont County using all types of firearms allowable under the United States Constitution and the laws of the State of Iowa, and

WHEREAS, the Fremont County Board of Supervisors were elected to represent the citizens of Fremont County, and have sworn by their Oath of Office to uphold the United States Constitution and the Constitution of the State of Iowa, and

WHEREAS, legislation is currently being considered or expected to be proposed by both the Federal Legislature and the Iowa Legislature that potentially seeks to infringe on the constitutionally protected right of citizens to keep and bear arms, and WHEREAS, the Fremont County Board of Supervisors wants to ensure that the rights of the citizens of Fremont County are protected, and

WHEREAS, the Fremont County Board of Supervisors understands that the Federal Legislature and the Iowa State Legislature cannot be solely trusted to protect citizens Second Amendment rights, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to declare that Fremont County is a Second Amendment Sanctuary County, as Fremont County opposes the enactment of any legislation or the issuance of executive order, that would infringe upon the constitutional right of the people of Fremont County to keep and bear arms.

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED that the Fremont County Board of Supervisors hereby declares Fremont County to be a Second Amendment Sanctuary County, and hereby states its opposition to the enactment of legislation, the issuance of executive order, or the promulgation of any regulation after the date of adoption of this resolution that would infringe upon the constitutionally protected natural right of the people of Fremont County to keep and bear arms and shall apply to persons who have not had their right to bear firearms legally terminated.

This resolution shall not prohibit the enforcement of any federal and/or state laws in effect at the time its adoption (including Iowa Code Chapter 724) and shall not be construed to require any action or inaction that would violate Iowa Code Section 27B.2. Passed and adopted this 12th day of January, 2022.

Motion by Sheldon to table the resolution appointing the eminent domain compensation commission members until they are able to fill vacant positions for the bankers. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Sheldon to Allow Chairman Hickey to sign intent to obligate funds for EN Bid Pkg. No. 4 – Site 20 for East/West Nishnabotna Watershed Project. Motion carried unanimously.

At 9:14 a.m., County Attorney Naeda Elliott and Assistant County Attorney Ryan Dale joined the meeting.

Motion by Sheldon to approve the following new hire for the sheriff's office. Motion carried unanimously. RESOLUTION NO. 2022-6

CONSTRUCTION EVALUATION RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Iowa Code section 459.304(3) sets out the procedure if a board of supervisors wishes to adopt a "construction evaluation resolution" relating to the construction of a confinement feeding operation structure; and

WHEREAS, only counties that have adopted a construction evaluation resolution can submit to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) an adopted recommendation to approve or disapprove a construction permit application regarding a proposed confinement feeding operation structure; and

WHEREAS, only counties that have adopted a construction evaluation resolution and submitted an adopted recommendation may contest the DNR's decision regarding a specific application; and

WHEREAS, by adopting a construction evaluation resolution the board of supervisors agrees to evaluate every construction permit application for a proposed confinement feeding operation structure received by the board of supervisors between February 1, 2022 and January 31, 2023 and submit an adopted recommendation regarding that application to the DNR; and

WHEREAS, the board of supervisors must conduct an evaluation of every construction permit application using the master matrix created in Iowa Code section 459.305, but the board's recommendation to the DNR may be based on the final score on the master matrix or may be based on reasons other than the final score on the master matrix;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF FREMONT COUNTY that the Board of Supervisors hereby adopts this construction evaluation resolution pursuant to Iowa Code section 459.304(3). /s/ Dustin Sheldon

In other business, the Recorder's Monthly Report and Sheriff's Monthly Report for December was approved.

At 9:33 a.m., there being no further business, Clark made a motion to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
