

The Fremont County Board of Supervisors met in a regular session, on Wednesday, September 6, 2023, in the Fremont County Courthouse Courtroom, with Chris Clark, Dustin Sheldon, and Clint Blackburn present. A quorum was declared, and the meeting was officially called to order at 9:00 a.m. The agenda was approved. The minutes of the previous board session were read and approved.

Let the records show that Attorney Peter Johnson, Treasurer Alise Snyder, Bob Drummond, and Liz Skillern with SWI Herald were present for this meeting.

Bob Drummond met with the board to discuss the purchase of a county held tax certificate for 204 Fletcher Street in Sidney. He told the board he has been to the city council to talk about it. Treasurer Alise Snyder advised that Drummond will attend the city council meeting on Monday night to ask that they waive the fees for the special assessment they have on it. Her recommendation is to table action on this because if they keep it on the cost is about \$8,000.00 and if they waive it that brings the cost to around \$2,500.00. Motion by Sheldon to table the purchase of the tax sale certificate until they find out what the city does. Motion carried unanimously.

The board discussed allowing use of the courthouse for Domestic Violence Awareness Month. Motion was made by Blackburn to approve use of courthouse in October for Domestic Violence Awareness Month the Clothesline Project. Motion carried unanimously.


Motion was made by Sheldon to approve the TIF reporting requirement to Department of Management. Motion carried unanimously.
