**City of Thurman
Public Measure IC**

Following public measure be

Thurman City Code of Chapter 1, Section 2-1-4 be as follows: The City Council have five City Council members in large. The three City Council members receive the highest votes at the 2025 election for a term of four years. The two receive the fewest votes at the 2025 election and will serve a term of two years. Council seats elected at the election shall serve a term of four years to stagger the staggering of the elections. Each Council member in 2027 and thereafter shall serve a term of four-years. Elections are held every odd numbered year.

On this measure would Ordinance No. 2021-10-11, amend the code of ordinances to change the term of city council positions from two years to four years and allow staggering of those terms after the next election.

On this measure would amend the existing Ordinance that all of the five city council positions are open for election every two years.

**Iowa Western Community College

Shall the following public measure be adopted?

Shall the Board of Directors of the Iowa Western Community College (Merged Area XIII) in the Counties of Adair, Adams, Audubon, Cass, Crawford, Fremont, Harrison, Mills, Monona, Montgomery, Page, Pottawattamie and Shelby, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$55,000,000 to provide funds to defray the cost of any one or more of the following purposes: to construct, furnish, and equip a new Career and Technical Education facility for automotive/diesel mechanic, commercial drivers' license, and logistics programming; to expand, improve, remodel, repair, furnish and equip existing buildings for expanded programming including HVAC, plumbing, welding, electrical, and construction technology for credit and non-credit programming?
