

NOTICE OF FREMONT COUNTY PRIMARY ELECTION

Notice is hereby given to qualified electors of Fremont County, Iowa, that a Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, June 2, 2026. A Freedom Vote Tabulator (FVT), handicap accessible marking device, and a Freedom Vote Scanner (FVS), machine with paper ballots will be used in the election process. Polling places will open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m.

Deadline to **vote absentee in-person**, at the Fremont County Auditor's Office is Monday, June 1, 2026, during regular business hours.

Any person unable to get to the polls on June 2, 2026, may send a written absentee ballot request to the Auditor's Office, P.O. Box 610, Sidney, IA 51652. **Deadline to request an absentee ballot by mail is May 18, 2026, at 5:00 p.m.**

VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS AT THE POLLS

Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on election day – and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor's Office by Monday, June 8, 2026, 12:00 p.m. noon. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification. 
