

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION – CITY OF HAMBURG

Notice is hereby given to the qualified electors of the City of Hamburg that a Special Election will be held on Tuesday, July 7th, 2026. A Freedom Vote Tabulator (FVT), handicap accessible marking device, and a Freedom Vote Scanner (FVS), machine with paper ballots will be used in the election process. Polling places will open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m.

The deadline to **vote absentee in-person** at the Fremont County Auditor's Office is Monday, July 6th, 2026, during regular business hours.

Any person unable to get to the polls on July 7th, 2026, may send a written absentee ballot request to the Auditor's Office, P.O. Box 610, Sidney, IA 51652. **Deadline to request an absentee ballot by mail is Monday, June 22nd, 2026.**

Voter pre-registration deadline is Monday, June 22nd, 2026, at 5:00 p.m.

Voter ID Requirement at the Polls

Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on election day – and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 2) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor's Office by Monday, July 13th, 2026, 12:00 p.m. noon. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification.
