

The Fremont County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Wednesday, August 4, 2021, in the Fremont County Courthouse Boardroom, with Sheldon, Hickey, and Clark present. A quorum was declared, and the meeting officially called to order at 9:00 a.m. Minutes of the previous board session were read and approved.

Let the records show that Engineer Dan Davis and Liz Skillern with Valley News Today were present for this meeting.

The board discussed two agreements. They are for the East/West Nishnabotna Watershed Pond Project Agreement and Terrace Project Agreement with Mark Laumann. These are being done in conjunction with NRCS. Motion by Hickey to sign the agreements. Motion carried unanimously.

Engineer Dan Davis met with the board for the signing of the following:

Motion by Hickey to allow Chairman Sheldon sign application for approval of underground construction in county highway ROW for MidAmerican Energy Company to bore a 2" conduit line north of Highway 2 to approximately 2300 feet south of the intersection of 320th Avenue and J-32. Motion carried unanimously.

The board discussed setting a date and having a first reading for a solar ordinance. At 9:04 a.m. the board called Assistant County Attorney Tyler Loontjer regarding this ordinance. He stated that we needed to set a hearing date and first reading of the solar ordinance to allow time for publication. Motion by Hickey to hold the public hearing and first reading on September 1, 2021, at 9:30 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Clark to allow Chairman Sheldon to sign an engagement letter for audit services with Gronewold, Bell, Kyhnn, & Co. for the FY21 audit. Motion carried unanimously.


In other business, the Recorder's Monthly Report for July was approved.

Claims were approved for August 6, 2021.
