

The Fremont County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Wednesday, December 1, 2021, in the Fremont County Courthouse Boardroom, with Hickey and Clark present. Let the record show that Sheldon was absent for that meeting. A quorum was declared, and the meeting officially called to order at 9:07 a.m. Minutes of the previous board session were read and approved.

Let the records show that County Attorney Naeda Elliott and Liz Skillern with Valley News Today were present for this meeting.

Wendy Mueller with West Central Community Action met with the board by telephone regarding the funding for FY22. She started by thanking the board for their support. They are requesting \$3,000 for FY 2022 and this is the same amount as last year. Mueller went over the client demographic information. They helped with head start, childcare resource and referral, weatherization, energy assistance, and WIC just to name a few. They provided \$763,603.00 total dollars for services in Fremont County in FY2021. Mueller discussed the 28E Agreement between WCCA and the following counties: Cass, Crawford, Fremont, Harrison, Mills Monona, Montgomery, Page, and Shelby, Iowa. This agreement is to allow them to receive the funding for services and is per the recommendation of the State Auditor. Motion by Clark to approve the budget allocation of \$3,000.00 along with the 28E Agreement for FY2022. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Clark to approve the following Resolution 2021-51. Motion carried unanimously.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Fremont County Board of Supervisors this 1st day of December 2021, that the following transfer of funds be approved and made: \$627,819.00 from the Rural Services Basic Fund, share of Rural Services taxes, to the Secondary Road Fund and \$61,231.00 property tax relief of local option taxes, from the Local Option Sales Tax Fund to the Secondary Road Fund.



Let the records show that Assistant County Attorney Tyler Loontjer and Cara Morgan were present for this meeting.

The board discussed purchasing stamped warrants for maintenance on Mule Slough/West Benton Drainage District. The district needs funds for annual maintenance and insurance expenses. They don't receive any more funds until next September. Iowa Code requires the trustees to maintain the district. They have roughly \$9,920.00 in expenses at this time. Hickey stated that the treasurer will check with the software company to see if as the money is collected in September part of it can be diverted from stamped warrant debt to operation and maintenance. Motion by Hickey to purchase stamped warrants for Mule Slough/West Benton Drainage District operation and maintenance only for no more than \$15,000.00 from today's date through August of 2022. Motion carried unanimously.


