

The Fremont County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Wednesday, May 5, 2021, in the Fremont County Courthouse Boardroom, with Sheldon, Hickey, and Clark present. A quorum was declared, and the meeting officially called to order at 9:00 a.m. Minutes of the previous board session were read and approved.

Let the records show that Assistant County Attorney Tyler Loontjer, Engineer Dan Davis, and Purchasing Agent Jeff Shirley were present for this meeting.

Engineer Dan Davis met with the board for the following:

Motion by Hickey to allow Chairman Sheldon to sign application for underground construction in county right-of-way for Windstream Communications to dig up cable, place a new pedestal and bore on 222nd Street to place a new drop to home in Section 8, Township 68, Range 42. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Hickey to allow Chairman Sheldon to sign the amended Secondary Roads Budget for 2021. Motion carried unanimously.

The board discussed the two pickups again for the road department. Purchasing Agent Shirley was informed by Woodhouse that the vehicle they were looking at was no longer available at the price they were quoted. They said they would have to go up a package and the additional cost would be over \$3,000 and would be \$33,864. Shirley spoke to Deery and they could provide a comparable vehicle for \$29,214. Motion by Hickey to amend the amended motion from last week and that the road department purchase both of their pickups from Deery due to a rise in the price from Woodhouse. Motion carried unanimously.

The board discussed the representation for Western Iowa Tourism Membership as discussed in the last meeting. Vice-Chairman Hickey stated that he spoke to John Whipple on the Welcome Center Board. They no longer wish to send representation to the meetings and would be fine with the tourism board sending a representative. Motion by Hickey to have the tourism board send the representative from this point on. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Hickey to Allow Chairman Sheldon to sign intent to obligate funds for East/West Nishnabotna Watershed Projects for Mount and Whitehill. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Hickey to approve new hire resolution for the Fremont County Attorney's Legal Assistant. Motion carried unanimously.


