

The Fremont County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Wednesday, November 3, 2021, in the Fremont County Courthouse Boardroom, with Sheldon, Hickey, and Clark present. A quorum was declared, and the meeting officially called to order at 9:00 a.m. Minutes of the previous board session were read and approved.

Let the records show that Engineer Dan Davis, Deputy Recorder Pam Daniels, and Liz Skillern with Valley News Today were present for this meeting.

Motion by Hickey to change the next two regular Wednesday board meeting dates to Tuesday, November 9th and Tuesday November 16th for election purposes. Motion carried unanimously.

Engineer Dan Davis met with the board for the following:

Motion by Clark to allow Chairman Sheldon to sign IDOT payment voucher engineering/surveying services for J-34 and L-31 per agreement through October 15, 2021. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Clark to allow Chairman Sheldon to sign IDOT payment voucher Engineering services for emergency repair construction on J-64 per agreement through July 31, 2021. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Hickey to allow Chairman Sheldon to sign IDOT payment voucher engineering services for emergency repair construction services on J-64 per agreement through October 15, 2021. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Hickey to allow Chairman Sheldon to sign IDOT payment voucher engineering services for J-24 emergency repairs from NB I-29 on/off ramps to west corporate limits of Thurman per agreement through October 15, 2021. Motion carried unanimously.

Assistant Auditor Sydney Dailey presented the board with the new Family Farm Applications for 2021 from the assessor. The assessor recommends denying the application because they are leasing/cash crop share agreement. Motion made by Hickey to deny the applications as presented by the assessor. Motion carried unanimously.


