A quorum was declared, and the meeting was officially called to order at 9:00 a.m. Clark moved to revise the agenda striking item eight homestead/military. It will be on next week's agenda. Motion by Blackburn to approve the agenda as amended. Motion carried unanimously. The minutes of the previous board session were read and approved.

Let the records show that Attorney Peter Johnson, Engineer Dan Davis, Maintenance Superintendent Jeff Shirley, Tandon VanScyoc, Suzanne Watson, and Liz Skillern with SWI Herald were present for this meeting.

Engineer Dan Davis met with the board for the signing of the following:

Motion by Sheldon to allow Chairman Clark to sign work in ROW permit for Asplundh Tree, working for Mid-American, to clear trees in ROW to install new transmission line from Percival to Sidney. Motion carried unanimously. Davis also stated that the DOT has embargoed the bridge east of Sidney now that they applied asphalt on it.

Suzanne Watson with the Southwest Iowa Mental Health Region met with the board to update them on happenings in the region since the passing of HF471. She stated she was thankful to have Chief Deputy Tim Bothwell on the board. She thinks with a sheriff's office member on the board they will utilize more services. She discussed recent changes in the make up of the board. The transition from the county funding to state funding has gone well. She said they may not need the 28E going forward but that remains to be seen. She discussed the various departments of health and human services. She said there are efficiencies that they are looking at so there may be regional changes after that and the next legislative sessions. Fremont County has 4% of the region's population. Mental Health Crisis Response Team will respond via telehealth through a deputy sheriff's computer at their home, emergency room, the side of the road, etc. They recommended services for the patient. They are then offered crisis stabilization services. In 2023, the team saw 768 and there were 610 interventions. She stated there are eight service coordinators in the region. The sheriff's office is currently utilizing mental health medication reimbursement from the region and can also use integrated telehealth partners to do visits in the jails.

The board discussed the safety coordinator position. The position has been vacated with Jeff Shirley's change in job duties. After consulting with HR, the board was told they can appoint the position from within. At 9:31 a.m., EMC Clayton Long joined the meeting. The board asked if he would take the position. He agreed. Motion by Sheldon to appoint Clayton Long as safety coordinator. Motion carried unanimously.

Emergency Management Coordinator Clayton Long and Danielle Briggs with SWIPCO did not meet with the board. She was not available at this time.

The board discussed opening applications for the Board of Adjustment due to a resignation. It was Dave Lueth whose term expires in April of 2024. Motion by Sheldon to post the opening with a deadline to apply of October 11, 2023, at 4:30 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Sheldon to approve the renewal of a Class B and Sunday Sales Liquor License for Sidney Foods LTD. Motion carried unanimously.
