FREMONT COUNTY IOWA ORDINANCE NO. 2011-2

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ELECTION PRECINCTS IN ALL UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF
FREMONT COUNTY, IOWA

WHEREAS, the 2010 Federal Decennial Census has been conducted and completed with an
official census date of April 1, 2010, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Fremont County, Iowa, is required to review and adjust
election precinct boundaries within the County pursuant to Chapter 49 of the Code of Iowa,
and;

WHEREAS, the Fremont County Auditor has received and analyzed the census data and has
proposed precinct boundaries, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to amend Ordinance 2005-1 Section 3 – Precinct
Boundaries; and the Board of Supervisors, finds that the change will effect a substantial savings
in election costs, and;

WHEREAS, THE BOARD OF Supervisors has reviewed the proposed precincts and finds that they
are relatively easy to describe (being townships) and will result in precincts convenient to the
voters,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Fremont County Board of Supervisors as follows:

SECTION 1. SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 2005-1 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Farragut City, Fisher Township, Locust Grove Township, Walnut Township, Monroe Township, Imogene City, That portion of Shenandoah City that lies within Fremont County except census blocks 190719701001228 and 190719701001231

Green

That portion of Tabor City that lies within Fremont County, Green Township, Randolph City, Riverside Township, Thurman City, Scott Township

Riverton

Riverton City, Riverton Township, Madison Township

Sidney

Sidney City, Sidney Township, Prairie Township, Benton Township

Washington Township/Hamburg Ward 1:

Hamburg Ward 1, including Golden Acres, and Washington Township


The precincts will include all area, both town and rural, lying within the boundaries of said precinct, with the exception of the city of Hamburg, Iowa.

This Ordinance to amend Ordinance 2005-1 shall be in effect on January 15, 2012, until such a time when the federal decennial census is taken in 2020. Precincts shall be effective on January 15, 2012 and changes made to precincts in years other than the year following the year in which the federal decennial census is taken shall be filed with the State Commissioner, Code of Iowa 49.7.



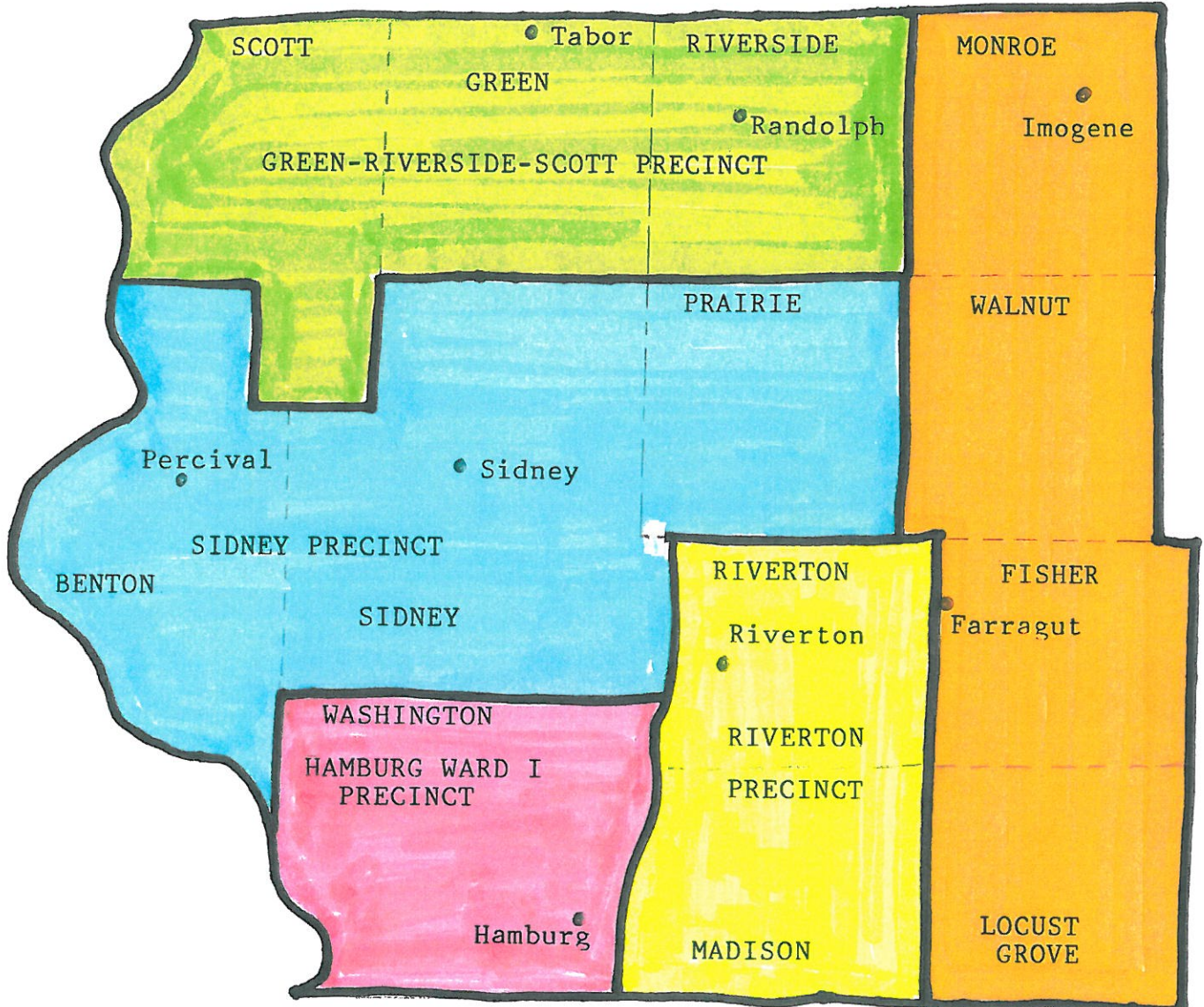

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

The parties to this agreement are the City of Hamburg, Iowa ("City") and Fremont County, Iowa ("County"). This agreement is entered into as of Sept. 6, 2011.

- 1. Following the federal decennial census, and after the redistricting of congressional and legislative districts, city councils and county boards of supervisors are required to complete any changes in precinct and ward boundaries (for cities) or precinct and supervisor districts (for counties).
2. Election precincts which are composed partially of unincorporated territory within a county and partially of a part of a city may be established, if an agreement which is mutually satisfactory to the board of supervisors of the county and to the city council of the city is adopted and submitted to the state commissioner as part of the certification of precinct boundaries.
3. The City of Hamburg and the County of Fremont desire to have one combined precinct.

Therefore, the parties agree to the provisions set forth below:

- 1. Hamburg Ward I including Golden Acres, of the incorporated area of City, which is that portion of the incorporated City of Hamburg which lies in Fremont County, all of which is part of the Twenty-Third (23rd) Legislative District, and Washington Township in of the unincorporated area of the County, shall be and hereby are established as a single election precinct.
2. A copy of this agreement shall be submitted by the City and the County to the State Commissioner as a part of the certification of precinct boundaries required by Sections 49.7, Code of Iowa.

AGREEMENT TO COMBINE CITY AND COUNTY PRECINCTS

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 30th day of August 2011, by and between THE CITY OF SHENANDOAH, IOWA, herein called the "CITY", and FREMONT COUNTY, IOWA, herein called the "COUNTY".

RECITALS

1. City and County are political subdivisions of the State of Iowa, and are subject to Chapter 49, Code of Iowa.
2. Section 49.6, Code of Iowa, provides that election precincts composed partially of unincorporated territory and partially of all or any part of a City may be established within a single County in any manner which is not contrary to Section 49.3, Code of Iowa.
3. Section 49.6, Code of Iowa, authorizes the City Council of the City involved and the Board of Supervisors to adopt an agreement mutually satisfactory, for the purpose of establishing an election precinct composed of such incorporated and unincorporated areas.
4. City and County desire to establish precincts pursuant to the authority of Section 49.6, Code of Iowa, as hereinafter provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, exercising the power granted by Section 49.6, Code of Iowa, the Parties do hereby agree as follows:

1. Precinct 4, of the incorporated area of City, which is that portion of the incorporated City of Shenandoah which lies in Fremont County, EXCEPT Census Blocks 190719701001228 and 190719701001231, all of which is a part of the Twelfth (12th) Iowa Senate District and the Twenty-third (23rd) Iowa House District, and Farragut Precinct of the unincorporated area of County, which includes Fisher Township, Locust Grove Township, Walnut Township and Monroe Township, shall be and hereby are established as an election precinct.

2. Precinct 1, of the incorporated area of City, includes the following two (2) portions of the incorporated City of Shenandoah, and shall be and hereby are established as an election precinct:

- (a) That portion of the incorporated area of the City of Shenandoah, which lies in **Fremont County**, north of Sheridan Avenue, (old Iowa State Highway #2), and identified as Census Blocks 190719701001228 and 190719701001231, all of which is a part of the Twelfth (12th) Iowa Senate District, and a part of the Twenty-third (23rd) Iowa House District;

AND

- (b) That portion of the incorporated area of the City of Shenandoah, which lies in **Page County**, and is a part of the Twelfth (12th) Iowa Senate District and the Twenty-fourth (24th) Iowa House District, and which is described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the east corporate limits and Washington Avenue, which is a point on the boundary of the Third Precinct, west and north along the boundary of the Third Precinct to the intersection of Thomas Avenue and Clarinda Avenue, which is a point on the boundary of the Third Precinct, then west along West Thomas Avenue to the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad, then southwest along the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad to Fifth Avenue, then west along Fifth Avenue to Fremont Street, then north along Fremont Street to the corporate limits, then east and south along the corporate limits to Washington Avenue, the place of beginning.

3. A copy of this Agreement shall be submitted by the City and the County to the State Commissioner as a part of the certification of precinct boundaries required by Section 49.7, Code of Iowa.
